- Estimates for the number of uninsured persons have been rounded to the nearest 100 persons.
- Data have been weighted to reflect the age, sex, geographic, and Hispanic status of the state of Utah.
- Population size estimates reported are from previously-published HSS reports and do not reflect post-publication revisions released by the Governor's Office of Planning and Budget (GOPB).
- Self-employed persons may be employed full or part time.
- The Utah Health Status Survey was not conducted in 2002.
